Dear 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Families,

This letter includes the Supply List for your student for the 2017-2018 school years. In addition to a few supplies we ask you to purchase, each student is asked to provide \$25 cash or a check made out to St Edward School. The money will be used to purchase dictionaries (for 5<sup>th</sup> grade students and students new to the school), and other items that the students will use up during the year. There are two reasons why we are asking for money rather than the actual supplies:

- a) Our research shows that the supplies your student needs will cost less if we purchase them in a bulk quantity. The \$25 will buy more supplies for each student than if each family purchased those supplies separately. We like saving you money!
- b) We put a lot more responsibility on the students to be independent, organized and responsible for their work and belongings. Learning organization is a critical part of preparing for junior high and high school, and each student needs to have the same materials in order for the process to work.

So that we can begin our year in an organized fashion, please send the cash/check with your student on the first day of school so that we can purchase the necessary materials.

- 1 pair 8" scissors (Fiskar brand if possible)
- 1 large pencil **pouch/bag**
