The purpose of the contest is to stimulate interest in mathematics and to provide recognition for achievement in this academic area. Problem solving, mental math and cooperative activities will be given particular attention. The contest includes three sections: written, oral, and group exams. **Calculators** will be allowed on the written and group exams. Students must bring their own calculators.

Your teacher has some sample test items to share with you.

We are pleased to offer individual scholarships to 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. This year we will offer a total of \$14,000 in scholarship opportunities to 8<sup>th</sup> grade participants. These are partial tuition scholarships to Bishop Blanchet High School.

**SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS FOR 8<sup>TH</sup> GRADE STUDENTS**

\$5000 scholarship for 1<sup>st</sup> place

\$3000 scholarship for 2<sup>nd</sup> place

\$2000 scholarships for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> place

7<sup>th</sup> grade award winners will also be recognized. All participants will receive a **CERTIFICATE OF MERIT**.

**SCHOOL AWARDS** will be determined by the total scores of the top five participants from each school.

Refreshments will be served to all participants as they await contest results.

Students must be **registered by their teacher** who has the information for online registration.

A maximum of fifteen students may enter from your school.

There will be no registration fee for participation in the contest.

**The registration deadline is Tuesday, October 30th, 2018.**

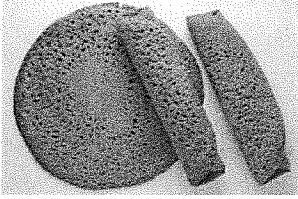

# Islandwood Injera Lunch Sale

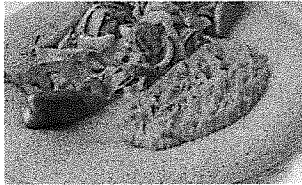


## Order form

Sauce choices with ingredients *(Select no more than 2):*

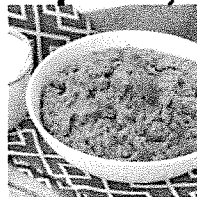
- Shiro with salad:** bean powder, onion, garlic, canola oil, water.
